Voting Information and Polling Locations

Key dates leading to the August 4, 2020 vote:

- Final day to register in any manner other than in-person with the local clerk for the May election.
- In-person only registration at local clerk w/ proof of residency
- Absentee Ballots returned in person to local clerk
- Election Day

Absentee ballots are available 45 days prior to the election. Contact the local clerk's office for registration and voting questions.

To register to vote, a person must be:

- a U.S. citizen
- at least 18 years of age by election day
- a resident of Michigan and the city or township where you applying to vote

You may obtain the application at one of the following:

- Your local Secretary of State branch office
- Your local county, city, or township clerk's office
- Offices of several state agencies, like the Department of Human Services, the Department of Community Health, and the Department of Labor and Economic Growth
- Military recruitment centers
- Voter registration drives

To vote in the August 4, 2020 School Election, a person must be a resident of the Goodrich Area Schools District and be registered to vote by August 4, 2020**

**After July 21, 2020, you must register in person and with proof of residency at the Township Clerk's office.
